3. **Angles on a Straight Line:** Sum to 180° .
4. **Angles Around a Point:** Sum to 360° .

b. Triangles

d. Circles

1. **Radius (r):** Distance from the center to any point on the circle.

2. **Diameter (d):** Distance across the circle through the center ($d = 2r$).

3. **Circumference:** The distance around the circle.

1. $C = 2\pi r$ or $C = \pi d$

4. **Area:** $A = \pi r^2$

5. **Arc Length:** A fraction of the circumference.

6. **Area of a Sector:** A fraction of the total area.

e. 3D Geometry (Solids)

While less frequent than 2D, some basic solid geometry is tested.

1. **Rectangular Solid (Box):**

1. **Volume:** length $\times$ width $\times$ height

2. **Surface Area:** $2(\text{lw} + \text{lh} + \text{wh})$

2. **Cube:** A rectangular solid with all sides equal.

1. **Volume:** side³

2. **Surface Area:** $6 \times \text{side}^2$

3. **Cylinder:**

1. **Volume:** $\pi r^2 h$

2. **Surface Area:** $2\pi r h + 2\pi r^2$ (lateral surface area + area of two bases)

4. Data Sufficiency (DS)

This section of the GMAT requires you to determine if you have enough information to answer a question, not to actually solve it. Understanding the underlying math is crucial for evaluating the sufficiency of statements.

While there are no specific "formulas" for DS, the ability to quickly recall and apply concepts from arithmetic, algebra, and geometry is essential. You need to be able to:

1. Identify the core question being asked.

5. Probability and Combinatorics
