The FHE allows you to exclude a portion of your housing expenses, while the FHD allows you to deduct the excess of your reasonable housing expenses over a base amount, if you don't qualify for the FHE or if your expenses exceed the FHE limit.

Similar to the FEIE, there are limitations on the amount of housing expenses you can exclude or deduct. The FHE is limited to 30% of the FEIE amount for the year. For example, in 2023, if your FEIE was \$120,000, the maximum housing exclusion would be \$36,000. The FHE is subject to a ceiling amount, which varies by location. Any housing expenses exceeding the FHE limit can potentially be deducted as part of the FHD. The base amount for the FHD is 16% of the maximum FEIE for the year.
