If you're using wooden dowels or branches, ensure they are the same length and smooth. If using branches, sand them down and consider applying a wood stain or sealant for protection and a polished look. If you're pre-drilling holes for the rope at the top, do this now.

Step 2: Cut the Fabric Panels

This is where precise measurements are key. For a four-pole teepee, you'll be creating four identical triangular panels.

1. **Measure the Height:** Decide on the desired height of your teepee from the floor to where the poles will meet. Add a few inches for seam allowance at the top and bottom.
2. **Measure the Base Width:** For four panels, the total circumference of the base will be divided by

four. A good starting point for a 4-foot diameter base is roughly 38 inches per panel edge that sits on the floor.

3. **Cut the Triangles:** You'll be cutting isosceles triangles. The two equal sides will be your height (plus seam allowance), and the base of the triangle will be your calculated base width. When laid out flat, the fabric will form a large isosceles triangle.
4. **Hemming:** Hem all edges of each fabric panel. Fold over about 1/2 inch and then another 1/2 inch to create a clean, durable hem. This will prevent fraying.

Tip: It can be helpful to sketch out your triangle dimensions on paper first to visualize it. Consider using a larger piece of paper or cardboard as a template.

Step 3: Sew the Panels Together

Lay two panels right sides together and sew along one of the long, slanted edges using your sewing machine. Repeat this process, sewing the other long edge of one panel to the next, and so on, until you have joined all four panels. You should end up with a long, rectangular piece of fabric with slanted edges. Finally, sew the two raw ends of this long piece

together to form a cone or cylinder shape.

Step 4: Create a Pocket for the Poles (Optional but Recommended)

To make your teepee more stable and allow for easy disassembly, create pockets or channels at the bottom of each panel where the poles can be inserted.

1. Fold up the bottom hem of each panel by about 4-6 inches (depending on the diameter of your poles).
2. Sew along the top edge of this folded section, creating a pocket. Ensure the pocket is wide enough to comfortably accommodate your poles.
3. **Alternative:** Instead of sewing pockets, you can simply allow the poles to rest inside the teepee and secure them with rope later.

Step 5: Assemble the Pole Structure

Gather your four poles. Stand them up and bring the tops together. Thread your strong rope or twine through the pre-drilled holes (if you made them) or simply tie it securely around the point where the poles meet. You want to create a stable, tripod-like base with the poles angled outwards at the bottom. Adjust the tension of the rope to ensure the structure is firm.

Step 6: Drape the Fabric

Carefully drape your fabric cone over the assembled pole structure. The poles should now be secured inside the fabric, either in the pockets you created or simply held in place by the fabric and the rope at the top.

Step 7: Secure the Fabric to the Poles

If you didn't create pockets, you'll need to secure the fabric to the poles. You can do this by tying additional lengths of rope from the top of each pole, wrapping them around the fabric and pole, and knotting them securely. Ensure the fabric is taut and evenly distributed.

Step 8: Create an Opening

Your teepee will need an entrance. You can simply leave one of the fabric panels slightly open or intentionally create a flap. To create a flap, you can:

1. Decide where you want your opening to be.
2. Cut a vertical slit down the middle of one panel, stopping a few inches from the top.
3. Hem the cut edges of this slit to prevent fraying.
4. You can leave it as is, or add ties or Velcro to

secure it closed when desired.
