Hybrid System Warning Light (Red/Yellow)

When this light illuminates, it signals a potential issue with the hybrid system itself, which includes the hybrid battery, electric motor, inverter, and power control unit. This light can appear in red or yellow, with red typically indicating a more urgent situation.

Potential Causes:

1. **Hybrid Battery Degradation or Failure:** Over time, hybrid batteries lose capacity. If the degradation is significant, the system will warn you.
2. **Inverter or Converter Malfunction:** These components manage the flow of electricity between the engine and the battery.

Battery Warning Light (Red)

This light, often resembling a battery, is typically associated with the 12-volt auxiliary battery, not the main hybrid battery. The Prius uses a conventional 12-volt battery to power electronics when the hybrid system is not active, start the gasoline engine, and manage various control modules. If this light illuminates, it suggests a problem with the charging system or the 12-volt battery itself.

Potential Causes:

1. **Faulty Alternator:** The alternator is responsible for charging the 12-volt battery.
2. **Weak or Dead 12-Volt Battery:** The battery may have reached the end of its lifespan.
3. **Loose or Corroded Battery Terminals:** Poor connections can prevent proper charging.
4. **Issues with the DC-DC Converter:** This component is responsible for charging the 12-volt battery from the hybrid system.

Recommendation: Drive to the nearest safe location. Continuing to drive with a failing 12-volt battery can lead to electrical system failures and the inability to start the car. Have the charging system and battery inspected immediately.

Brake System Warning Light (Red)

Depicted as an exclamation mark within a circle or the word "BRAKE," this light indicates a problem with the braking system. This is a critical safety warning that should never be ignored.

Potential Causes:

1. **Low Brake Fluid Level:** This is the most common cause. It could indicate a leak in the brake lines or a worn brake pad.

2. **Parking Brake Engaged:** Ensure the parking brake is fully disengaged.

Airbag Warning Light (Red)

This symbol, typically an airbag icon, indicates a problem with the vehicle's supplemental restraint system (SRS), which includes the airbags and seatbelt pretensioners. A malfunctioning airbag system means the airbags may not deploy in an accident, or they could deploy unexpectedly.

Potential Causes:

1. **Faulty Occupant Classification System (OCS) Sensor:** These sensors determine if a passenger is present and their weight.
2. **Airbag Control Module Issues:** Problems with the SRS computer.
3. **Loose or Disconnected Airbag Connectors:** Especially under the seats.
4. **Seatbelt Sensor Malfunction:** Issues with the sensors that detect seatbelt usage.

Recommendation: This is a critical safety warning. Do not ignore it. Have the SRS system diagnosed and repaired immediately by a qualified technician. It's essential to ensure your airbags are operational before driving.

Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS) Light (Yellow/Amber)

Depicted as a flat tire with an exclamation mark inside, this light indicates that one or more of your tires are significantly underinflated. Properly inflated tires are crucial for safety, fuel efficiency, and tire longevity.

Potential Causes:

1. **Underinflated Tire(s):** The most common reason.

These systems help prevent skids and loss of traction. If the light is flashing, it means the system is actively working to maintain control. If it's solid, it indicates a fault.
