Step 5: Repent of Your Sins and Accept Jesus Christ as Your Savior and Lord

This is the call to action, the point where the individual responds to God's gracious provision. Graham would explain "repentance" not just as feeling sorry for sins, but as a change of mind and direction – turning away from sin and turning towards God. This is often referred to as the [process of repentance](#), a sincere turning from one's old ways.

Accepting Jesus Christ as Savior means believing that His sacrifice has paid the penalty for your sins and that you are forgiven. Accepting Him as Lord means surrendering your life to His authority and guidance, inviting Him to be the ruler of your life. This involves a personal decision, a conscious act of faith. Many of Graham's crusades would culminate in an invitation for people to come forward and make this commitment, signifying their embrace of the "Steps to Peace with God."

This step is about personal faith and commitment. It's the moment when the theological truths presented in the previous steps are internalized and acted upon. The [importance of faith](#) cannot be overstated here; it is the conduit through which God's grace is received. This active decision is what initiates the personal experience of peace with God.

True repentance leads to a transformed life. It's not about self-punishment but about a genuine desire to please God and live a life that reflects His love and character. This transformation is often evidenced by a changed attitude towards sin, a greater love for God and others, and a desire to live according to biblical principles. The Holy Spirit plays a vital role in enabling this ongoing process of sanctification.

Graham's emphasis on repentance was always paired with the assurance of God's forgiveness. This balanced approach ensured that individuals were not paralyzed by guilt but empowered by the knowledge that God is merciful and ready to forgive those who turn to Him. The ongoing journey of repentance

fosters humility and dependence on God, further deepening the experience of peace.
